
University of Pennsylvania Police Department (UPPD)

- Work in partnership with Philadelphia Police Department, DEA, Septa Transit Police, Emergency Response Team (ERT), Secret Service, and Crisis Negotiators to ensure preparedness for emergency response

(SEAMLESS handoff to the UCD)



How to Request a Walking Escort:


- Ask any Public Safety Officer on patrol or inside a building




Information and Security Technology & PennComm Emergency Communications Center
